FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who is performing at Googfest 2025?

Headliner: Samantha Jade (approx. 8pm-9pm)

Matthew Charles Band (approx. 6pm-8pm)

Last Call (approx. 5pm-6pm)

2. Is this event ticketed or free?

This is a free event, and everyone is welcome!

3. What time/date and where is the event?

5pm-9pm Saturday 15 February 2025 at Rockley Oval, Rockley Parade Googong (access via Wellsvale Drive Googong).

4. Are non-Googonians allowed to come?

Yes! Everyone is welcome!

5. Is it ok for little kids? Is this an all-ages event?

Yes! Everyone is welcome!

6. Is there dedicated parking?

Free parking is available in a dedicated parking site, which is accessible via [Wellsvale Drive Googong](#). Traffic marshals are on site to assist. **Disabled parking** is available – ask the traffic marshals.

7. Are there *free* buses from Canberra/Queanbeyan/Jerrabomberra?

Yes, we have *free* buses departing (and returning) from Woden, Jerrabomberra and Queanbeyan.

A timetable is available on our website (see [Googong.net](#) and click on Events, and Googfest 2025). Googong is otherwise serviced by QCity Transit with ticketed/paid rides.

8. Are there buses looping around Googong?

No. Rockley Oval is centrally located in the town. It is less than 1km from all homes in the town.

9. Are there Fireworks this year?

No there are no fireworks.

10. Are dogs allowed?

Yes, well-mannered dogs are allowed to join the fun, but they must be on a leash.

11. Are there food vendors?

Yes, there will be a range of food vendors there for purchase on the night. You can also bring a picnic. There is no alcohol available for purchase, but you may bring your own alcohol!

12. What roads are closed?

13. If I have friends visiting, can they come to my house?

I'm a local, can I still get through to my home?

Yes. Access is permitted for residents and their visitors. No proof is required – just explain your destination address to the traffic marshals.

14. Are businesses impacted (e.g. The Googong North Village Centre, Aquatots)?

No businesses will be impacted by the traffic arrangements.

15. Can I have a stall at the event?

16. What is there to see/do?

This is a music festival and visitors are encouraged to bring a picnic and sit back to enjoy an evening of live music. There is a playground at the oval suitable for children up to 13 years. Food vendors will be available.
