In the current climate of a national housing shortage in Australian real estate, Flagstone is crucially important as one of the nation's largest urban housing release areas.

In development news, the last stage in the Latitude release is now sold out ahead of construction completion which is due in August. State Government Update

Queensland Budget: Putting Money Back in Your Pockets

Hi Flagstonians!

I know cost of living pressures are impacting everyone right now, which is why the Queensland Government has announced the largest cost-of-living package through our recent 2024-25 State Budget. Here's a breakdown of what you can expect:

\$1,300 off Power Bills

From 1 July, households across Queensland will enjoy a \$1,300 rebate on their power bills. This is a joint effort, with \$1,000 provided upfront by the Miles Government and an additional \$300 spread out over the year courtesy of the Albanese Government.

Expanding the FairPlay Program

All children aged 5-17 will now be eligible for one of our extremely popular FairPlay vouchers to assist with the cost of playing sport. On top of this, we have also increased the amount of these vouchers from \$150 to \$200. The next round will be released after 1 July.

20% Off Rego

Registration fees for cars, utes, bikes and trailers will be reduced by 20%. This means savings for all Queenslanders, with the reduced fees appearing on rego notices from 5 August 2024.

Public Transport for Just 50 Cents

As of 5 August, all Translink public transport services will be available for just 50c per trip. Whether you're commuting within Flagstone or venturing beyond, the fare remains the same. This is a significant reduction aimed at making public transport more accessible.

Savings for First Home Buyers

We're raising the stamp duty threshold for first home buyers from \$500,000 to \$700,000, saving potential buyers up to \$17,350.

The First Home Owner Grant has also been doubled from \$15,000 to \$30,000 for contracts signed between 20 November 2023 and 30 June 2025.



Freeze on Fees and Charges

To provide further financial stability, we are implementing a freeze on fees and charges for the 2024-25 financial year. This affects things such as drivers' licenses, emergency management levies, transport and hospital charges, fishing permits and more.

With increases in numbers of families and children using the Adventure Playground on Flagstonian Drive and residents' feedback on road use in the area. I am investigating the installation of raised speed platforms in front of the Adventure Playground area, to reduce speeding and improve safety for our children and park users.

I would like to thank the community for being patient while the resurfacing works were completed on River Oak Drive and Silver Wattle Drive. It is great to see these completed. If you see or know of a road that needs repair work, please don't hesitate to get in contact with me.



Get active and join the local social netball competition.

On Thursday nights at the Flagstone courts, the Flagstone Netball Club are running the Fast5 Netball competition. Open to 14 years plus, males and females.

Teams can have a maximum of 8 players. Only 5 players take to the court, dropping the traditional wing positions. If you are part of a mixed team you can only have 2 males on the court at any one time either in attack or defence.

The season will run for 14 rounds with games scheduled at either 6.15pm or 7pm. A game consists of 8 minute quarters with 2 minute breaks between each quarter.

Fast5 allows attackers to score 1, 2 and 3 pointer shots with one quarter for each team being a Powerplay quarter and all goal points are doubled. Teams play rolling subs which allows you to go hard and then take a breather and return to the court.

The season starts on Thursday 11 July and will conclude on 7 November. All players will need to register via the

Netball Connect App hosted by Netball QLD. Players will pay \$140 for the season or \$10 weekly plus a one-off annual Netball QLD insurance fee of \$37. Players already playing netball in QLD will not have to pay the \$37 if already registered with Netball QLD for 2024.

To register as a player, click on the QR link below. Create an account and enter the 4280 postcode, then search Flagstone Netball Club. Choose Flagstone Netball Social Competition and select division Fast5 and complete the registration and submit.


